Tribal College Dual Enrollment Program – A.R.S. 15-244.01

- Provides access to higher education for Arizona high school students
- Diné College, Navajo Technical University, Tohono O’odham Community College
- Reimbursements for tuition, fees, books, and instructional materials



Johnson O’Malley (JOM) – 25 CFR Part 273

- Addresses the unique educational needs of eligible American Indian and Alaska Native students
- 28 grantees (26 LEAs and 2 Tribes)
- Indian Education Parent Committee



Native American Code Writers Initiative Program – A.R.S. 15-249.17

- Supports the introduction of code writing curriculum for students in grades 9-12
- Instruct Native American students in computer code writing and technology-focused education
- Current Grantees – Arizona Science Center and University of Arizona



OIE RISE GRANT

Grant Goals

- 1) Students and staff benefit from **programs and opportunities** that focus on academic preparation for college, career, and community leadership, for identity development, and for holistic well-being.
- 2) Funded projects act as **“bright spots”** for future investment by the ADE Office of Indian Education to expand and/or replicate successful programs based on community needs and desires in Indigenous Education.

Funded programs will participate in a three-year process

- **Year 1:** Stakeholders and community engagement, plan development
- **Year 2:** Implementation plan
- **Year 3:** Continued plan implementation while building sustainable practices and programs
