SRES Hybrid Model

The schedule below will be activated to decrease the number of people on campus.

- Every Wednesday, all students will be remote. This will allow teachers and paraprofessionals time to plan, grade, and meet with colleagues as needed. Public Works will complete a deep clean of the entire building on Wednesdays.
- Special populations may meet at the school daily under arrangement with administration.
- ESS Resources: Students will have the option to get their minutes met in a face-to-face setting every weekday (except Wednesdays).

- Students in grades F.A.C.E., 2, 6, and 2/3 combo will learn on-campus (in person) on Mondays and Thursdays. On Tuesdays and Fridays, these students will learn remotely at home and log in to class via MS Teams.
- Students in grades Kinder, 1, 3, 4, and 5 will learn on-campus (in person) on Tuesdays and Fridays. On Mondays and Thursdays, these students will learn remotely at home and log in to class via MS Teams.
- All students will learn remotely at home on Wednesdays. Work on these days will be asynchronous, meaning students will work on their own from printed packets or online.

SRES Remote Model

- We will distribute student laptops and/or tablets to students the first few days of school. First,
 parents/guardians must sign the Technology Agreement. Once the form is returned to the school, the student
 will be issued their technology. If SRES moves to remote learning, students will already have the technology
 needed to learn successfully at home.
- In cases where the student does not yet have school-issued technology, SRES staff will contact families to pick up their assigned equipment from the school. If necessary (and safe to do so), staff may deliver equipment to the student's home.
- We will communicate with our families through a variety of ways, including phone calls, text messages, emails, Class Dojo, regular mail, and our website (SRES.SaltRiverSchools.org). Families must ensure the school has their most updated contact information on file.
- Teachers will engage with students through MS Teams on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.
 Wednesdays will be used for asynchronous learning (printed worksheets and/or online work at the student's own pace) to allow teachers time to plan and prepare for the coming week, as well as to meet with individual students and their families, as needed.
- Progress reports and grades will be collected and shared with families on schedule.
- Staff will work on-site and provide online instruction to students from SRES classrooms. Staff who exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 will work remotely from home, if able.
- Salt River Schools Food Services will distribute pre-packaged breakfast and lunch meals for families to pick up curbside (drive-thru style) from the ECEC Cafetorium. Meals are available to any student ages 18 and younger.
